

Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Expands Evidence Lockers and Property Storage

The Tulsa County Sheriff's Office needed more room for property and evidence operations in a new building. Southwest Solutions Group installed high-density evidence storage, evidence lockers, and dedicated storage areas designed to increase capacity, improve security, speed evidence retrieval, and improve organization.

Evidence Lockers & High Density Storage

The project used a powered high-density system to address a total lack of storage space and no room for growth.

High-density storage, evidence lockers, and dedicated gun room and drug room shelving improved secure property and evidence storage.

OPERATIONAL GOAL

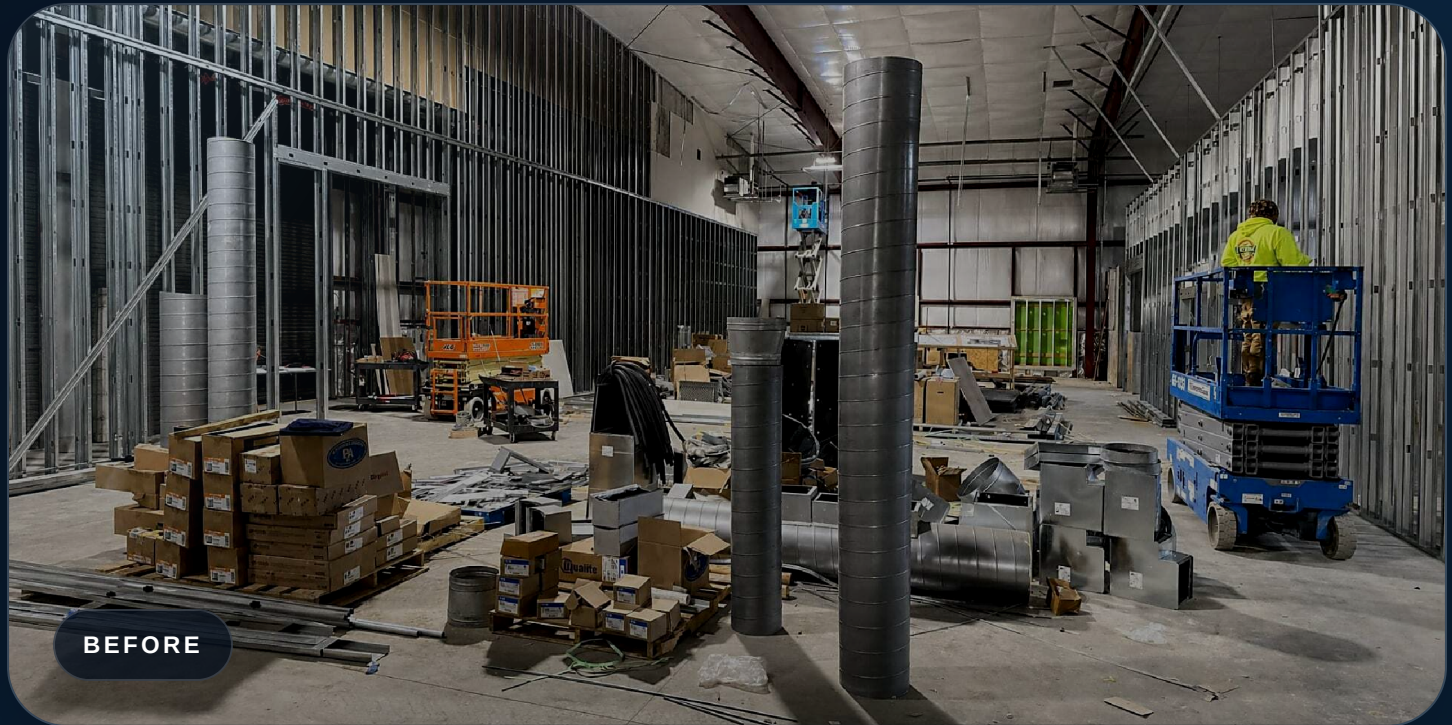
Expand Evidence Storage Capacity

The department needed increased storage capacity, improved security, faster retrieval, and better organization.

THE PROBLEM

A Property and Evidence Room With No Room to Grow

The Tulsa County Sheriff's Office property and evidence building had reached its storage limit, leaving the department without room for current needs or future growth. The new building needed a larger, more secure storage plan that could improve organization and make evidence retrieval faster. The project driver was a total lack of space.

No Remaining Storage Capacity

The existing property and evidence building was out of room. The department needed a larger storage environment to support its property and evidence operation.

No Room For Growth

The space problem was not limited to day-to-day storage pressure. The department also needed a system that could support continued property and evidence demands in the new building.

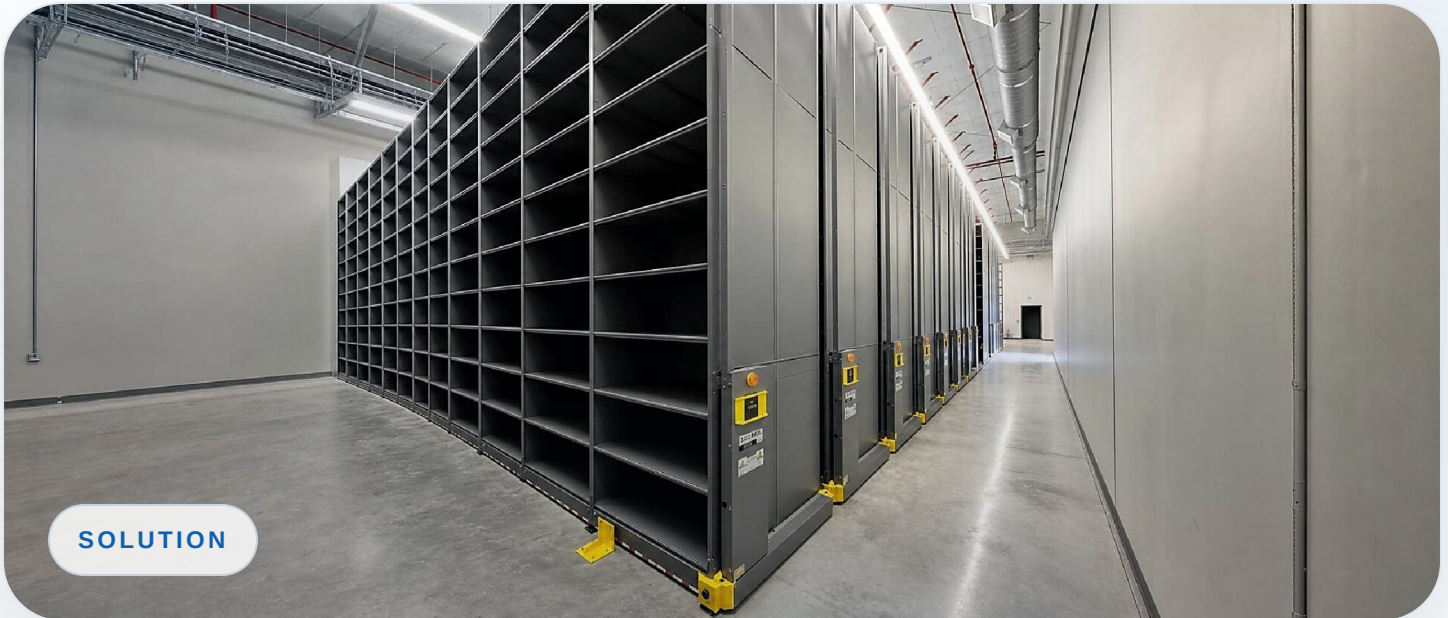
Evidence Access And Control Needs

Faster retrieval, improved security, and better organization were identified as project results. The storage approach needed to support controlled access across property, evidence, gun room, and drug room storage areas.

THE SOLUTION

A Powered High-Density Evidence Storage System Built For Scale

Southwest Solutions Group designed a high-density storage solution featuring evidence lockers, powered mobile storage, and dedicated gun room and drug room shelving. The system created secure storage areas while improving organization, retrieval speed, and future storage capacity.

WHAT WE INSTALLED

15-Foot High-Density Evidence Storage System

The installed scope included a 15-foot-high powered high-density system. Evidence lockers and shelving for gun room and drug room storage were included to support separate evidence handling needs.

WHY IT FIT

Designed for a Growing Evidence Room

The department needed a storage system for a new building because the existing property and evidence space had no room for growth. A powered high-density system fit the need for greater capacity in a structured law enforcement evidence storage environment.

OPERATIONAL IMPACT

More Capacity With Better Evidence Control

The project addressed the documented goals of increased storage capacity, improved security, faster retrieval, and better organization. The completed installation is also noted as the largest property and evidence system in the State of Oklahoma.

Installing A Large Evidence Storage System In A New Building

Project notes identify an installation start date of May 1, 2023, with a four-month installation summary for the new Tulsa County Sheriff's Office property and evidence building. The work centered on fitting a large powered high-density system, evidence lockers, and dedicated gun room and drug room shelving into a facility planned to relieve a total lack of space. Available drawings supported layout coordination for the 15-foot storage system.

DISCOVERY & SITE SURVEY

Defining Property And Evidence Storage Needs

Discovery focused on the department's lack of space, property and evidence storage requirements, and the needs of the new building. The review supported planning for the 15-foot-high powered system, evidence lockers, and dedicated gun room and drug room shelving.

02

LAYOUT & STORAGE PLANNING

Planning The Powered High-Density Layout

Layout planning addressed the high-density storage footprint and access needs within the new facility. The powered system requirements were coordinated with the building plan so the equipment could be placed for property and evidence use.

03

SUBMITTALS & APPROVALS

Coordinating Storage System Documentation

Project documentation included available drawings, including a plan view for the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office project. This documentation supported coordination of the storage scope before installation in the new building.

04

FABRICATION & DELIVERY

Coordinating System Components For Installation

The high-density system, evidence lockers, and shelving were coordinated for delivery based on project needs. The process kept the main powered system and the separate evidence storage areas aligned with the installation plan.

05

INSTALLATION & TRAINING

Installing The System

The installation included the powered system, evidence lockers, and shelving for the gun room and drug room. The work prepared the property and evidence department to use the new storage system in daily operations.

06

MAINTENANCE & SUPPORT

Planning For Long-Term System Use

A large powered high-density evidence storage system requires clear access for future service needs. Long-term support planning helps keep the storage system practical for ongoing property and evidence operations.

RESULTS

More Capacity, Better Control, And Faster Evidence Access

The completed project gave the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office a larger, more organized evidence room with high-density storage, evidence lockers, and dedicated storage areas for firearms and narcotics. Reported measurable results included increased storage capacity, improved security, faster retrieval, and better organization.

PRIMARY OUTCOME

Expanded Evidence Storage Capacity

The project directly addressed the department's total lack of space by adding a large high-density storage system in the new building. The system is identified as the largest property and evidence system in the State of Oklahoma.

WORKFLOW

Faster Evidence Retrieval

Faster retrieval was one of the stated measurable results of the powered high density system. Evidence lockers and organized storage areas helped staff retrieve evidence faster while supporting secure evidence handling and chain of custody.

ORGANIZATION

Better Structured Evidence Areas

The project included storage for the main property and evidence area along with dedicated gun room and drug room shelving. That structure supported the stated result of better organization across different evidence storage needs.

LONG-TERM VALUE

A Larger Storage Foundation For Future Needs

The previous building had no room for growth, which drove the project. The new evidence storage system gives the department room to expand while supporting long-term property and evidence operations.
